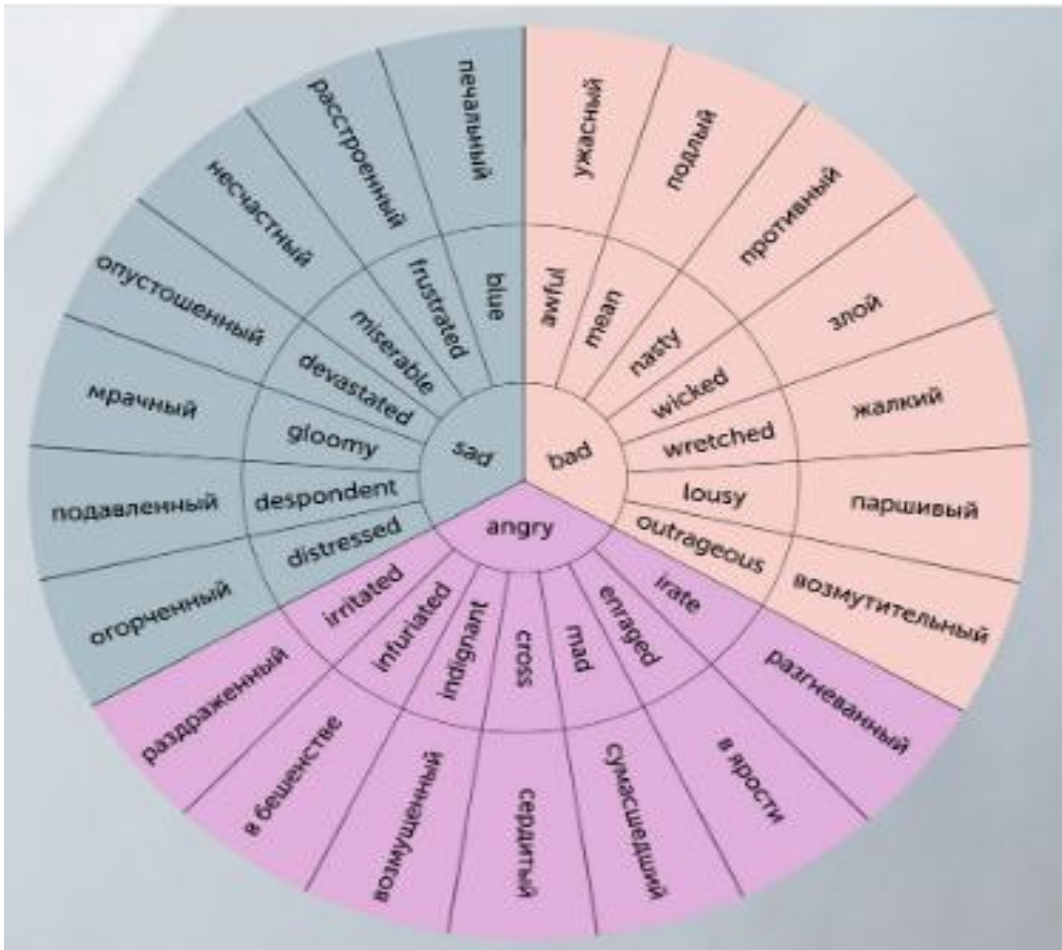
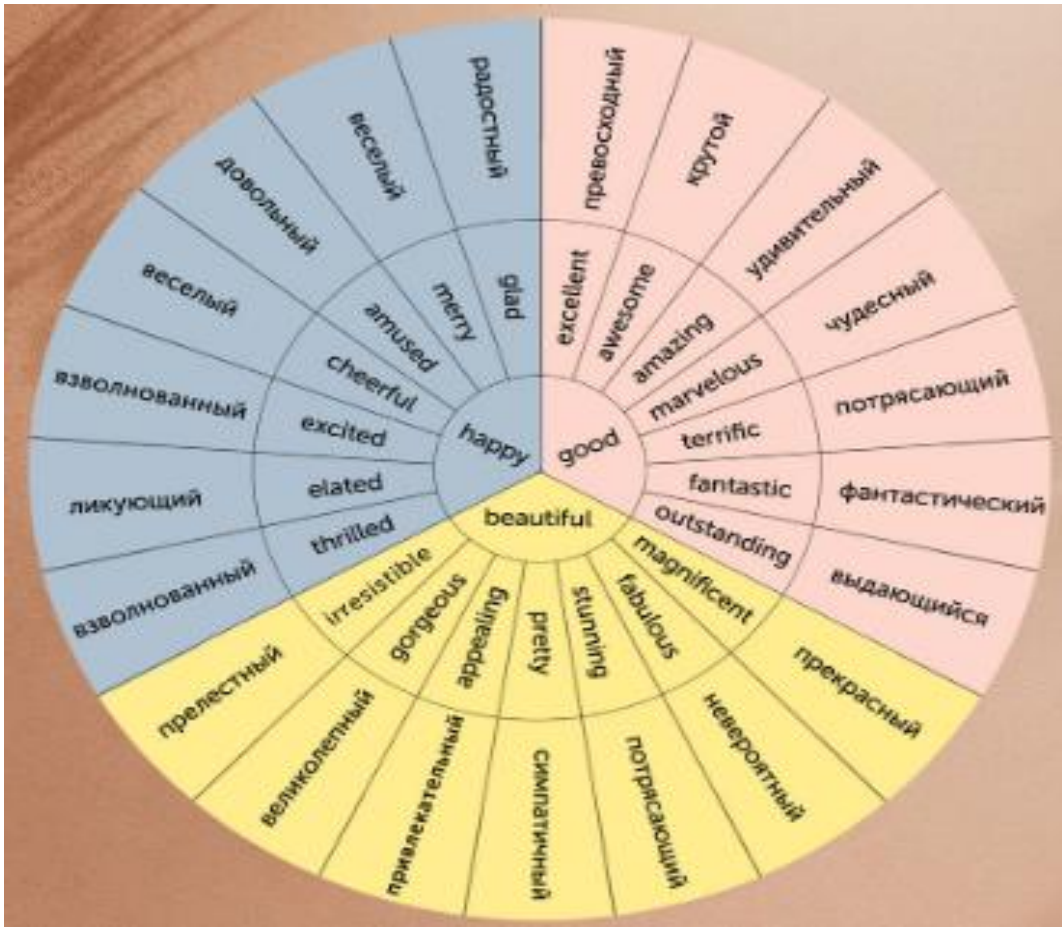

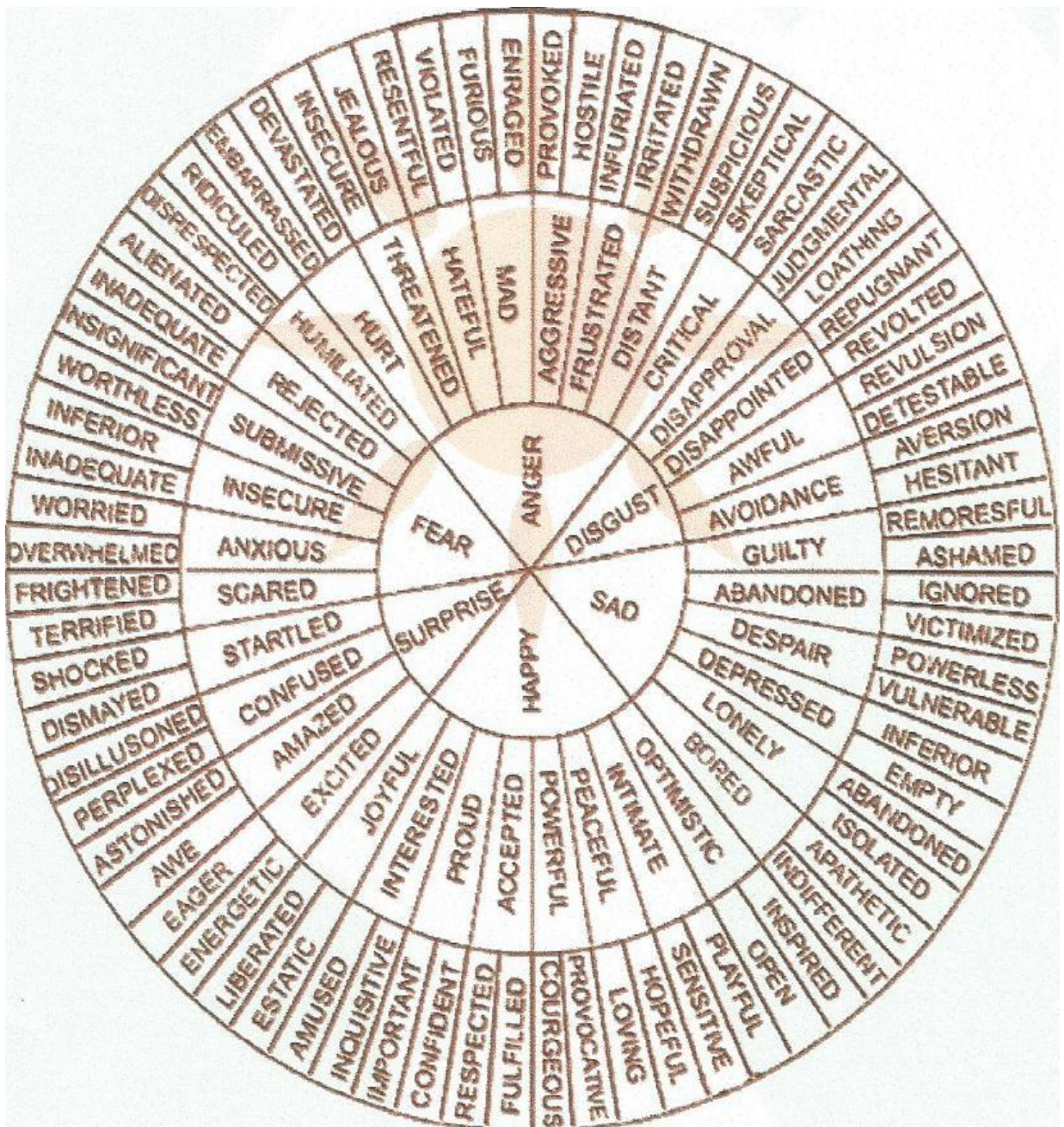


**Chorus:** Synonyms always agree. They like to live in harmony. Synonyms mean “the same.” They help the writer to explain.
