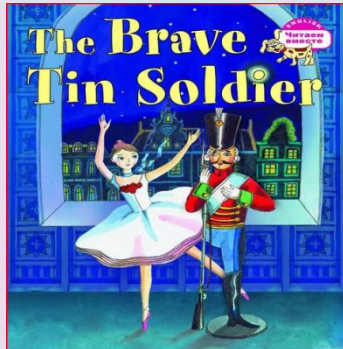


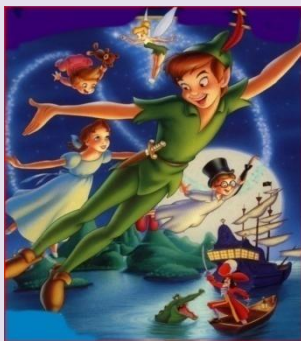
MY FAVOURITE CHARACTER IN A BOOK

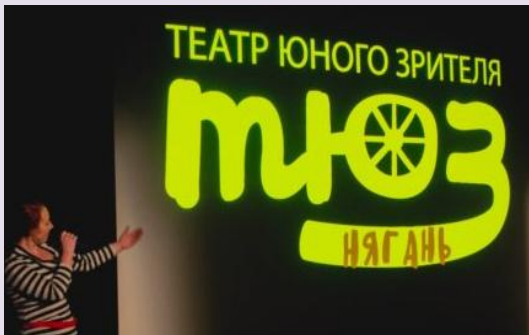

The theatre every year according to estimates, is visited by more than 20.000 people. There is a children's theatre studio «Eidos», which I visited.

Monument to the Soldier-Liberator

Victor Sysoev advised to create this monument. It was created by Moscow Art Fond.

The monument made for the thirtieth anniversary of the Great Victory. It shows the image of an unknown soldier who fought for the freedom of our country. Soldier-liberator stands on Pionerskaya Street, which was later called «30 years of Victory». Students made a square in front of which there is a monument. The monument made of bronze and on it there is an inscription «your Feat is immortal».

The residents of Nyagan were supposed to see the monument in 1975, but it happened only three years later. And now, every year on Victory Day citizens, veterans, school children and newly married come to this monument. **Eva Budyko 7A**



Shopping Center Oasis Plaza

Oasis Plaza is located on 28 Lenin Street. Oasis Plaza was built on September 2, 2012. There are 2 floors in the shopping center. There are 88 stores in Oasis Plaza where you can buy what you need. There are 64 stores on the ground floor and only 24 on the second floor. There is also a cinema, an amusement park and,



of course, fast food in the shopping center. It serves the territory with a population of more than 400 people. The coverage area of the center includes agglomeration of cities: Nyagan, Khanty-Mansiysk, Yogorsk, Sovetsky, Urai, as well as areas: Khanty-Mansaiysk, Oktyabsky, Beloyarsky, Berezovsky and Kondinsky. On three sides of the shopping center there are parking lots for 500 cars. The main parking for 380 cars and a shopping center are connected by an elevated warm passage equipped with escalators. Parking for 70 cars is located on the side of the grocery hypermarket. From Lenin Street there is a parking lot for 50 cars. Attendance of the center: in 2017 amounted to 3.950.857 people. The center is equipped with an automatic system for counting visitors. **Karina Kazakkulova 7A**



The complex was built to commemorate people who died for their country in the Great Patriotic War, the Afghan war, the Chechen war and lived in Nyagan. The memorial complex was opened on the 8th of May in 2005. The memorial complex includes the monument to George Pobedonosets, the Eternal flame, the walkway of Russian glory. The majestic monument to George Pobedonosets symbolizes generous self-sacrifice for the Motherland. The height of this granite statue is 12 meters. The monument is surrounded by the marble tops where the names of the war heroes are carved. Along the perimeter of the eternal flame there are granite cubes with the images of Russian medals. There are eight memorials to the great heroes of USSR.

The official opening ceremony of the fountain took place on the 3^d of September in 2013. The fountain is located in the central square of Nyagan town. It has got the coloured lights and inside the fountain there is a statuary. **Liz Protasova 7A**



Patriot

One of the tourist attractions in Nyagan is Patriot. Patriot is a sports center that includes sports tourism, hand-to-hand combat, motocross, futsal, equestrian. It's located on South street on the outskirts of the city. Periodically Patriot arranges competitions for example in equestrian sports. In the stables the coach teaches children vaulting – exercises on horseback and specialty jumping. Patriot often makes obstacle courses and small competitions. **Alyona Kurmieva 7A**



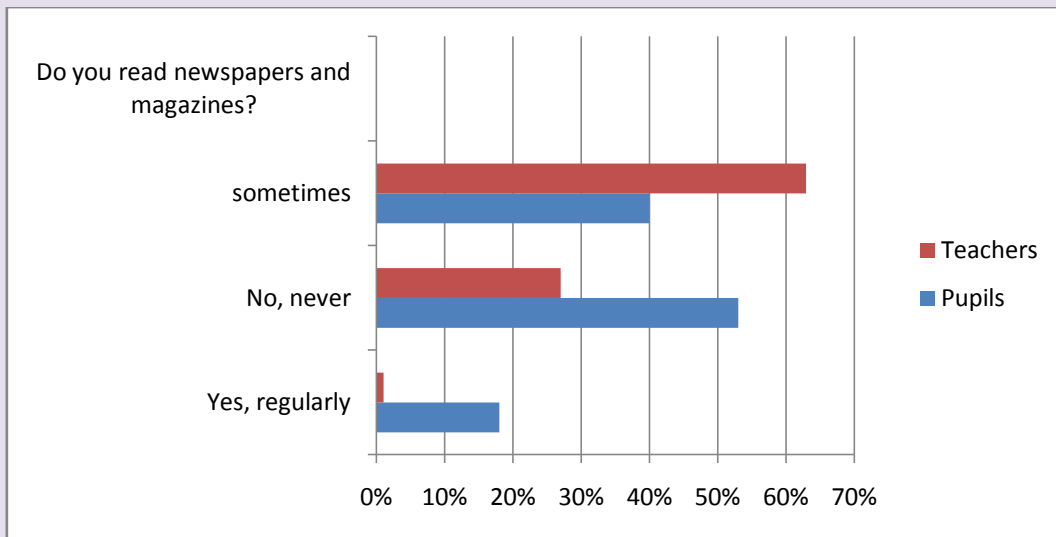

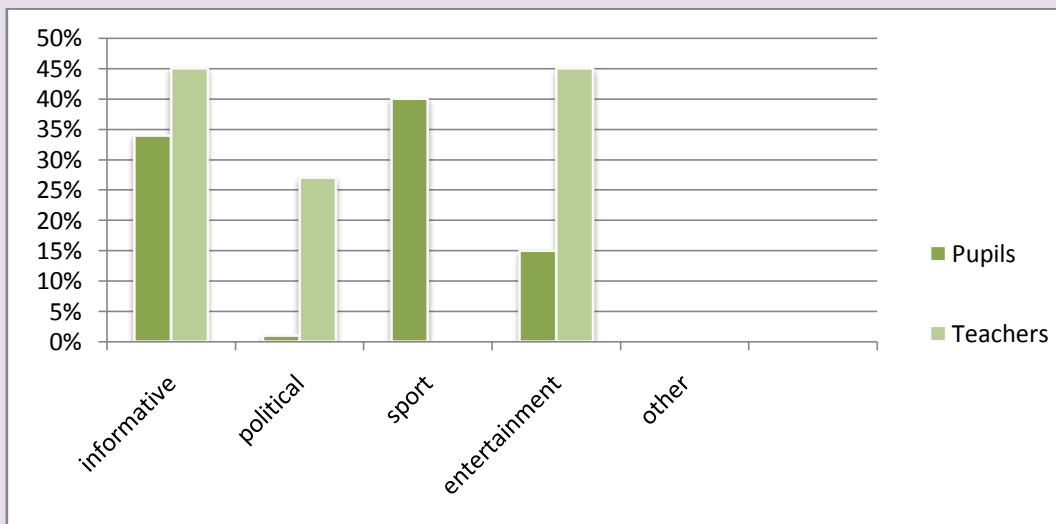

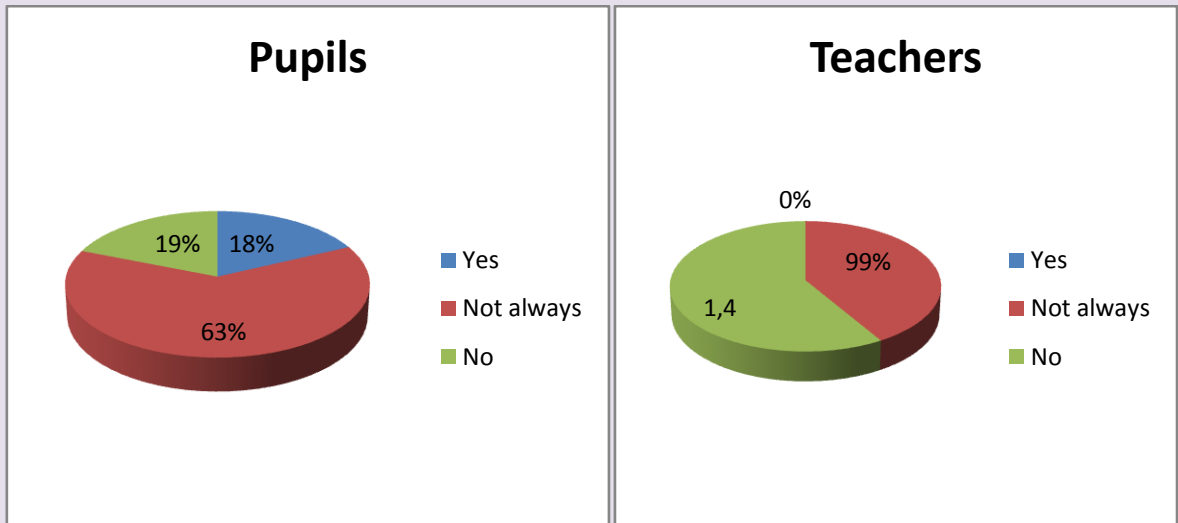

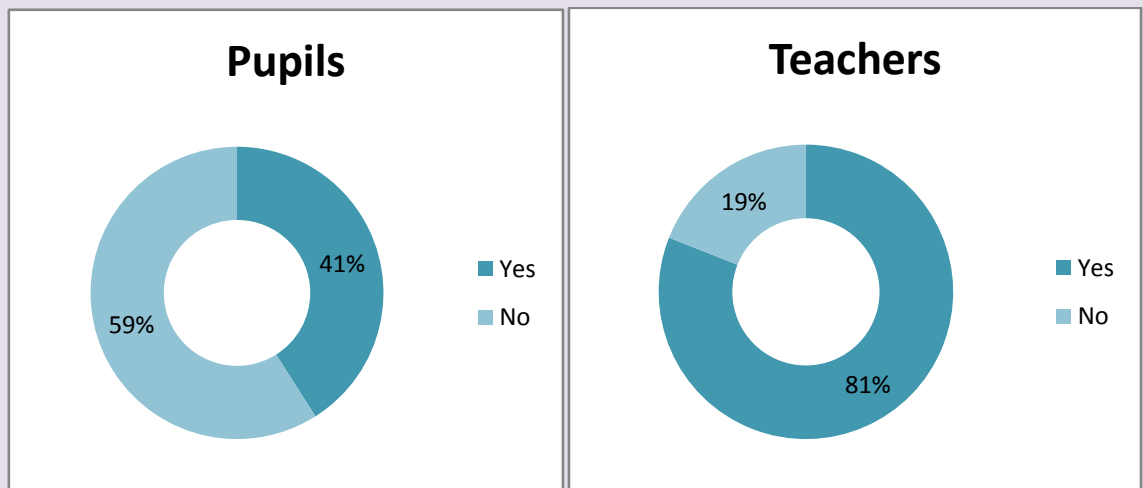
What types of newspapers and magazines do you prefer?



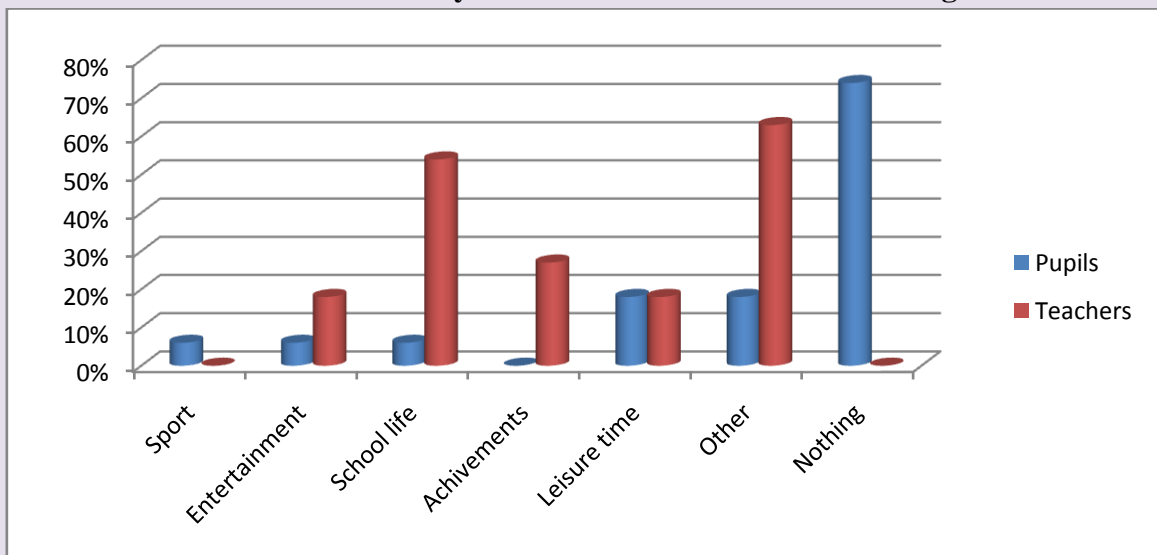
Are you satisfied with the information published in them?



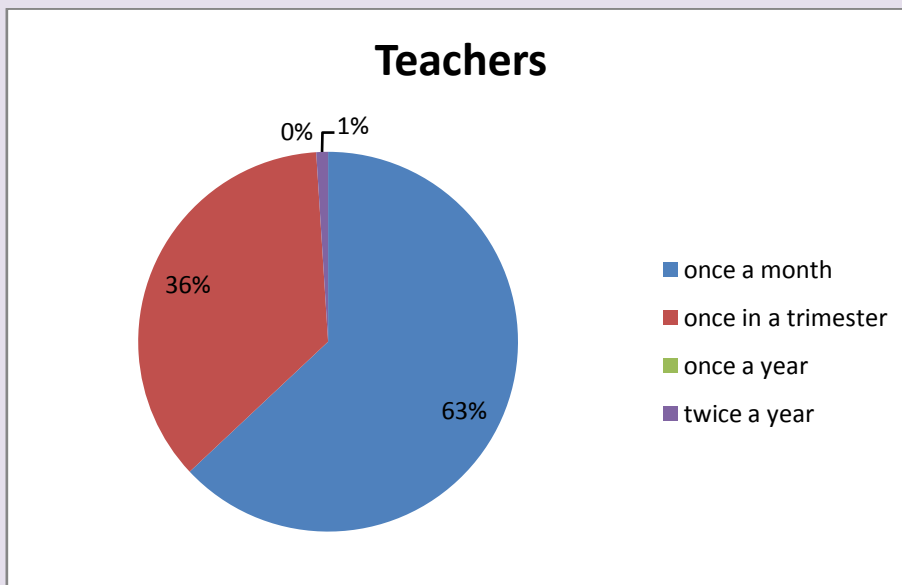
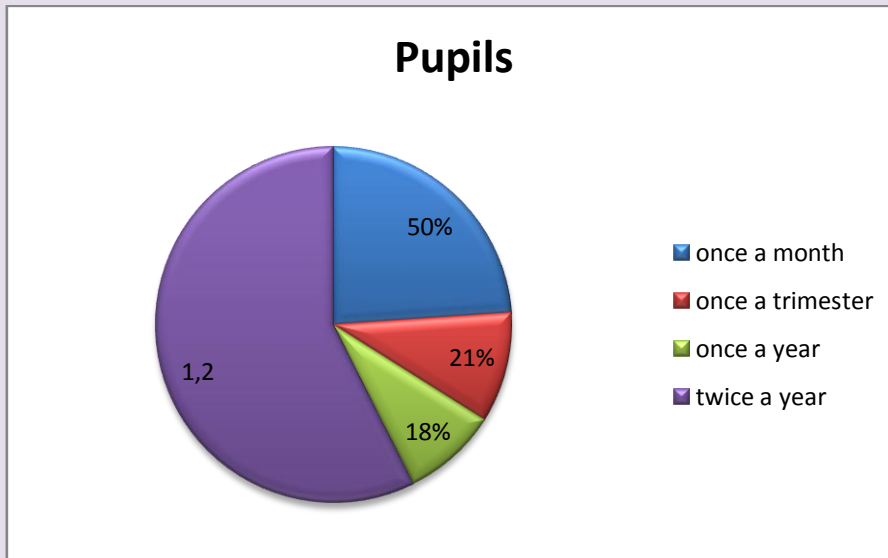
Do you think school newspaper and magazine are necessary?
